<p>In ayah # 49, what will the <i>mujrimun</i> be fearful of on the Day of Judgment?</p> <p><b>Answer: The Book (one's record) that leaves neither a small thing nor a big thing, but has recorded it with numbers. And they will find all that they did placed before them.</b></p>	<p>In ayah # 56, what did Allah say He sent the Messengers for?</p> <p><b>Answer: "And We send not the Messengers except as givers of glad tidings and warners."</b></p>
<p>What reason did Al-Khidr fix the wall that was falling down in the town of the people who refused to feed them?</p> <p><b>Answer: Under the wall there was a treasure that belonged to two orphan boys in the town and their father was a righteous man, and Allah intended that they should reach their age of full strength and take their treasure as a Mercy from Him.</b></p>	<p>What reason did Al-Khidr kill the boy?</p> <p><b>Answer: The boy's parents were believers and it was feared that he would oppress them by rebellion and disbelief.</b></p>
