Game Rules

1. Photocopy (or print) enough of the 'DeenGo[®]' Cards for each student. (Mount on cardboard or similar hard material and laminate for continued use without damage insha'allah).
2. Photocopy one set of call cards for yourself (the teacher/parent). This is optional but be sure you have an original insha'allah.
3. Give students different colour crayons or another object they can use to mark off the salat, parts of wudhu or pillar of Islam name when they hear it insha'allah. ***Keep in mind safety. If you chose to use objects make sure they cannot be swallowed by students and/or present a choking hazard.***
4. Say to the students: "I will say the name of a prayer, or the part of the body that we wash when we make wudu or one of the five pillars of Islam insha'allah. If you know what surah I'm reading, use your crayon to colour the box of the surah. The first student who gets five (5) boxes in a row (either straight across (horizontal), diagonal, or vertical) wins. You should raise your hand and when I call on you say, "DeenGo[®] alhamdulillah!"
5. Continue playing the game as long as students show interest or as time permits insha'allah.
