Quran قران

1. Who revealed the Quran?
2. What is the name of the angel that Allah sent to teach the Quran to the Prophet?
3. What was the name of the Prophet whom Allah sent the Quran to?
4. What month did Allah send the Quran to the Prophet Muhammad?
5. Will Allah send any other book to us after the Quran?

Prayer rug سجادة

1. What do we use this rug for?
2. What colour is this rug?
3. Where do we keep this rug?
4. Do you think more than one person can prayer on this rug at the same time? If so, how?
5. Please show me how we fold this rug when we are finished using it?
6. Let's put the prayer rug where it belongs so when we need it again it will be easy to find insha'Allah.

Hijab حجاب

1. What is this called?
2. Who wears a hijab?
3. Women wear the hijab on what part of their body?
4. What colour is this hijab?
5. How does hijab feel? Is it soft, smooth, etc.?
6. Allah has told Muslim women to wear the hijab whenever they go outside. He is happy when Muslim women wear the hijab. (For girls) What colour hijab would you wear when you go outside?
7. Recite the following verse for your child:
وَأَنِسُوا لَهُمْ شَرَّ مَا فَعَلُوا وَهُمْ فِيهَا
حجياً . Tell them this is the ayat in the Quran where Allah tells the Muslim woman to wear hijab.

Niqab نقاب

1. What is this called?
2. Who wears a niqab, men or women?
3. Women wear the niqab on what part of their body?
4. What colour is the niqab in the picture?
5. How do you think the niqab feels? Is it soft, smooth, etc. (if you own a niqab allow the child to feel it insha'Allah).

Siwak سواك

1. What is this called?
2. What colour is the siwak?
3. What does the siwak look like? (some children may say a branch, a tree, etc.)
4. What do we use the siwak for?
5. Tell the children that the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wa salam) used to use the siwak very often. Remind them that a Muslim tries to do what the Prophet did.
6. Tell the children this hadith (Bukhari): Allah's Apostle said, "I have told you very often to (use) the siwak. (The Prophet put emphasis on the use of the **siwak**.) Ask if they have ever used a siwak. What did it taste like? Ask, "do you think you would like to try to use the siwak each Friday insha'Allah?"

Misk مسك

1. What is this called?
2. What do you think it might smell like? (i.e. sweet, sour, bitter, etc.).
3. Let's smell the misk. Do you like the smell? Why or why not?
4. Who wears misk? Men or women?
5. What part of the body do you think men might put the misk on? (i.e. neck, face, hair, wrist, etc.)
6. Tell the child this hadith (Bukhari): "Allah's Apostle said, "The taking of a bath on Friday is compulsory for every male Muslim who has attained the age of puberty and (also) the cleaning of his teeth with siwak, and the **using of perfume** if it is available." (For Boys) encourage him to wear misk each jummah to do as the prophet (sallallahu alayhi wa salam) did.

Abaya عباية

1. What is this?
2. What colour is the abaya in the picture?
3. Have you seen an abaya with a different colour? Which colours have you seen?
4. Who wears an abaya?
5. How does the abaya feel? (i.e. soft, smooth, silky, etc.)
6. Talk about why the abaya is beautiful and how Allah wants Muslim women to wear the abaya when they leave their home.
7. Ask the child (if a girl) what colour abaya they would like to wear when they grow up insha'Allah.

Thawb ثوب

1. What is this?
2. What colour is the thawb in the picture?
3. Have you seen a thawb in a different colour? If so, which colour(s)?
4. Who wears a thawb (men or women)?
5. How does the thawb feel?
6. How does the thawb smell?
7. Talk about why the thawb is wonderful and how it distinguishes a Muslim man from a non-Muslim man and how Allah is pleased with Muslims who obey Him and love Him.
8. Ask the child (if a boy) what colour thawb they would like to wear when they grow up insha'Allah.
